Truckload Carriers Association Recognizes 2017 Fleet Safety Awards Winners

TCA's 42nd Annual Fleet Safety Awards, sponsored by Great West Casualty Company, honor trucking companies who have demonstrated an unparalleled commitment to safety. The top three winning companies in each of six divisions had the lowest accident frequency ratios per million miles annually.

“TCA is proud to honor the safest fleets in the United States and Canada,” said TCA President John Lyboldt. “The companies spotlighted in this contest have developed innovative programs that not only teach their professional drivers how to remain safe on our highways, but cultivate cultures in which the values of safety course through the entirety of their fleets.”
